<ul> <li>A person who is lone working must have a fully charged mobile telephone with him or her at all times</li> <li>Arrangements must be made for another person to contact the lone worker at regular intervals to ensure that they are safe and well</li> <li>Do not attempt to reach any items above head height without suitable means of access</li> <li>When required to reach for any item, only specific equipment to be used e.g. step-up or stepladder chairs, boxes etc).</li> <li>Ensure good housekeeping (no accumulation of rubbish, pallets etc shall be permitted)</li> <li>Manual handling training should be given to all persons who may have to work alone and attempt to heavy items,</li> <li>Trolleys or other handling devices to be made available and used to transfer any heavy items</li> <li>All waste must be disposed of in receptacles provided.</li> <li>When any liquid spillage occurs it must be dealt with immediately.</li> <li>All substances that are classed as hazardous must have a COSHH Assessment and must only be used by persons who have read the Assessment, use the product in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and maintain the control measures, including PPE.</li> <li>Where possible any potential violent or aggressive situation must be avoided</li> <li>Violent or aggressive behaviour includes verbal threats or abuse, unreasonable and/or offensive remarks or behaviour, rude gestures, intimidation, harassment, including sexual and racial abuse and threatening behaviour e.g. squaring-up without physical contact</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>Report to a Trustee immediately, any situations that may result or have resulted in a potential violent or aggressive confrontation</li> <li>If a person feels threatened in any way they should call for assistance, preferably by dialling 999 which</li> </ul>				
<ul> <li>often has the affect of causing a perpetrator to leave the area. Access to exits and extinguishers to be kept clear at all times.</li> <li>Fire extinguishers/equipment to be placed and properly mounted and serviced every year.</li> </ul>
